


#### **CULVER PARK HIGH SCHOOL**







A designated parking and drop-off is CPHS Info 3.3 An outdoor classroom space is desirable. To be equipped with power/data/Wi-Fi. **CPHS** Info Include outdoor athletic area striped for Basketball (1/2 court or full court if budget allows) CPHS Info and Soccer.


#### **ADDITIONAL ITEMS**


- 4.1 Huckabee presented two options for a conceptual building footprint based on the existing spaces. Principal Curry expressed preference for Option 1 with the following comments:
  - o Include windows in the classrooms for natural light and for visibility (passive supervision) of the outdoor play area and outdoor classroom space.
  - o Adult Day Program to have separate entrance.
  - Delete the Library and make the Wellness Center larger. In lieu of a library, provide a reading area with bookcases within (or adjacent to) the Wellness Center. Principal Curry to send an example from Inglewood for reference.
  - Move Psychologist out of the Administration Suite to be adjacent to the Wellness Center.
  - o Consider swapping the location of the Wellness Center and the Library. Huckabee to show plans of both options at the next meeting.
  - o The Teacher's Lounge should be separate from the Administration suite.
- 4.2 If interim housing is needed for Culver Park High School, a smaller, separate environment CPHS is better for the students.
- The next meeting to be held on 1/29/25 at 10:00 am and to include students per Principal CPHS request. Huckabee to send the agenda and associated materials two days in advance for the principal's review.
